

Château du Trignon is a domaine, located in Gigondas, about 90 hectares of vines spread over the appellations Gigondas, Vacqueyras, Rasteau, Beaume de Venise, Côtes du Rhône and its villages of Plan de Dieu and Sablet.

The Château offers a breathtaking view of the Dentelles de Montmirail.

Owned since 2006 by the Quiot Family, the Château du Trignon offers fine products in Côtes du Rhône and Crus from the Rhône Valley.

Rich in history, specific terroirs and intense cultural attention, the Château du Trignon is a gem to discover.

Origin of the name: the Trignon

The "Trignon" is the small stream that runs alongside the property and the castle. It then flows into the Ouvèze.

Anecdote:

In 1992, the Trignon was unleashed during the big rainy episodes in autumn. The harvest was destroyed, the cellar ransacked and under water. In memories, the mark on the wall indicating the rising waters is still here.



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Vinification on the domaine

The domaine naturally vinifies its own wines.

A gravity cellar was built in the seventies. Back then, this process was revolutionary. The traditional concrete vats are next to stainless steel vats with more technology for the white and rosés wines vinification.

The harvest is sorted on a sorting table.

A wooden aging cellar allows the tannins to be refined, in containers of different volumes, from 228 liter pieces to 40hl casks.
