



## Domaine du Vieux Lazaret Red

AOC Chateauneuf du Pape,

It's a delicious and supple wine, all about sharing and conviviality, perfectly pairing with meat dishes in sauce or grilled meats. Its aromas make this Châteauneuf-du-Pape to tasters ranging from beginners to the most connoisseurs.



### PRESENTATION

Our Domaine du Vieux Lazaret is one of the main estates of the Appellation and one of the oldest, dating from 1748. The domaine covers around 100 ha, spread over the 3 typical terroirs. All 13 grape varieties are cultivated on our lands. At the beginning of the 19th century, the Quiot family bought an old Lazaret (a hospice run by religious Lazarists who played a very important part at the time of the 1720 plague, when a third of the village population died) and built up a proper domaine by linking up plots of land owned on the commune. The « Domaine du Vieux Lazaret », built up over three centuries, by marriage, purchase and distribution, has this name since 1915.

### LOCATION

Our plots are spread all around the village, which allows us to benefit of the advantages the Appellation area can offer in terms of climatological varieties, terroirs and exposure. All 13 traditional allowed grape varieties are cultivated on our lands. This allows us balanced wines, all in finesse.

### TERROIR

3 major soil types : soils with rolled pebbles, stony terraces with sand and gravel sub-soils and clay soils formed from the limestone mother rock.

### IN THE VINEYARD

Our work as a winegrower, but above all as a farmer, requires us to ally ourselves with nature and to adapt to it. Depending on the year, this can be more or less difficult regarding the weather conditions. However, we must, through our cultivation practices, allow the plant to give us the optimum over time and to preserve our terroirs.

### WINEMAKING

Traditional vinification. Total de-stemming, pumping over twice a day. Vatting time : 2 to 3 weeks in concrete vats. Matured for 18 months in vats and barrels (15%).

Grenache noir, Syrah, Mourvèdre, Cinsault, Counoise, Muscardin, Vaccarèse, Terret noir

## TASTING

In his youth : deep crimson, ripe dark fruit, turning to spices. Smooth and persistent with aromatic fullness. This wine can be ageing as an old vintage. His spicy ripe fruit aromas then turn to prune, liquorice and black pepper compotes.

## FOOD PAIRINGS

Traditionals wine and food pairing : red meat, dishes cooked in sauce, meat terrine and cheeses. Don't hesitate to try it with a lamb tajine or a pan-fried forest mushrooms.

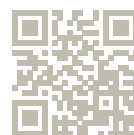

"Domaine de Vieux Lazaret is owned by the family Quiot, who has lived in the town of Châteauneuf du Pape for about 300 years. All the best parcels are - down to 1m depth - covered in potato-sized, round rocks that are terrible to work in. A shovel or chop does not last long in those fields. But all these round, bright stones are of great importance to the grapes. During the day, they reflect the sun's rays so that the grapes also get light from below, and at night they act like warmths that give off all the heat they have sucked in today's race. One of the secrets of the production of red Chateauneuf-du-Pape is a very long fermentation where shells and grains are in contact with the must for up to 21 days. Twice a day, the aunt is pumped over the shells to extract as many flavors, color and tannins as possible. The temperature during fermentation is kept at 30 degrees, which is checked automatically. After the fermentation, the wine is tested by the authorities. The last flavor component is derived from farm storage for several months on brand new oak barrels from central France.

All the wines are bottled on the special bottles of flax. These bottles may only be used by wine-growers in Chateauneuf-du-Pape, who tap their wines on the property. Chateauneuf-du-Pape Rouge has a deep crimson color and an aroma of mature dark berries and spices. The taste is soft and persistent with good filling."

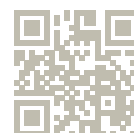

"(ENGLISH VERSION) - For ten generations since 1748, that is, for more than 260 years and before the French Revolution, the Quiot family has grown wine in Châteauneuf du Pape. The still family-owned Vignobles Jérôme Quiot, currently led by Florence Quiot, is in the heart of Châteauneuf du Pape. There, they own the two vineyards Domaine du Vieux Lazaret and Domaine Duclaux. (Since 1999, Domaine du Vieux Lazaret Châteauneuf-du-Pape has been available in Systembolaget's regular assortment both as a whole and a half bottle and now the wine is also available on magnum's bottle). A total of 13 grapes are included in the wine, which is dominated by Cinsault, Mourvèdre, Syrah and Grenache Noir. The grapes, which grow in three different soils - clay, sand and stone - are stripped, pressed and then fermented on cement tanks for 2-3 weeks with "pumping over" twice a day. Then the wine is stored on cement tanks and large oak barrels, so-called "Foudres", for 18 months. The name "Vieux Lazaret" originates from the 17th century. There was, then, in the village of Châteauneuf-du-Pape, a "Lazaret", that is, a monastery town run by monks (Lazarister) who received old, poor and sick people in connection with the plague ravages of the 1620s. Lazaristder was founded in 1625 by Saint Vincent de Paul to preach the gospel to the poor and to mission and help the sick.

(SWEDISH VERSION) - FI tio generationer sedan 1748, det vill säga i mer än 260 år och före den franska revolutionen har Familjen Quiot odlat vin i Châteauneuf du Pape. Det fortfarande familjeägda vineriet Vignobles Jérôme Quiot, som idag leds av Florence Quiot, ligger i hjärtat av Châteauneuf du Pape. Där äger man de två vingårdarna Domaine du Vieux Lazaret och Domaine Duclaux. Sedan 1999 finns Domaine du Vieux Lazaret Châteauneuf-du-Pape i Systembolagets ordinarie sortiment både som hel- och halvflaska och nu blir vinet alltså även tillgängligt på magnumbutelj. Totalt ingår 13 druvor i vinet, som dock domineras av Cinsault, Mourvèdre, Syrah samt Grenache Noir. Druvorna, som växer i tre olika jordmåner - lera, sand och sten - avstjälkas, pressas och jäser sedan på cementtankar i 2-3 veckor med "pumping over" 2 gånger per dag. Därefter lagras vinet på cementtankar och stora ekfat, s.k. "foudres", i 18 månader. Namnet "Vieux Lazaret" har sitt ursprung från 1600-talet. Det fanns då, i byn Châteauneuf-du-Pape, ett "Lazaret", det vill säga ett klosterhärbärge skött av munkar (Lazarister) som tog emot gamla, fattiga och sjuka människor i samband med pestens härjningar på 1620-talet. Lazaristorden grundades 1625 av Saint Vincent de Paul för att predika evangeliet för de fattiga samt att missionera och hjälpa sjuka."

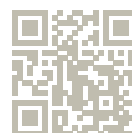
